## Summer Term's topic is Life on Earth



This is a cross curricular topic which will be covering history, geography, science, art and DT.

We will be:

- discussing why living things need to reproduce and study the life cycles of humans, mammals, amphibians, insects and birds (Science)
- studying the scientists such as Charles Darwin & David Attenborough who have increased our understanding of this (History)
- comparing peoples and places in our local area, the UK, Europe, North America and South America.
- tasting and preparing food from these places(Cookery)

# As part of this topic we will be making a visit to Kenley Airfield as part of our study of the history of our local area (Letter to follow).

Things you could do at home to support the topic include:

- Practice telling the time and reading timetables
- Visit Charles Darwin's home
- Use maps and atlases
- Practise preparing salads (chopping, grating, peeling)

All children should read for **at least 20 minutes** each day to an adult or older sibling at home. We ask that you sign their Reading Record each time you hear them read. Reading records are checked and House points awarded for at least five entries signed by an adult a week. We set the children challenge of reading 10 books by the end of the term.

## Housekeeping
