Autumn 1 Term's topic is Ourselves

This is a cross curricular topic which will be covering all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage.

We will be:

- Talking about ourselves and our families.
- Talking about things we like and dislike.
- Painting a self portrait
- Looking at how we are special and what makes us different to others.
- Learning to write our name correctly.
- Listen and discuss the story of 'The Rainbow Fish'.



Further learning this term:

English

- Fiction – Rainbow Fish and children’s favourite stories from home.
- Non-Fiction - We will look at fact books about our bodies
- Phonics- we will be learning some initial sounds.

Maths

- Counting to 10.
- Matching numerals to the correct quantities.
- 2D shapes.

Religious Education

Following the Come and See we will focus on our Ourselves topic, learning that God knows us by our name and loves us all.
