Autumn Term's topic is Italy and The Romans

Geography – We will be learning about all things Italian, specifically Rome, ancient and modern, as part of our European place study. This will also include map work, atlases and a recap on volcanoes. (Pompeii)

Art and D & T – We will be developing drawing skills, creating a pop-up book, our own mosaics and making a 'Roman' shield.
