We are pleased to be able to offer the Year 5 children the opportunity to go to Blackland Farm on Friday 20th May 2022 followed by a sleepover in the school hall.

This will be an Outdoor Learning Day and the pupils will take part in a very exciting programme, including abseiling, bungee trampolining and nightline. Please visit the website at the address above to see more details.

We will be travelling by coach to the centre and the children will need to be at school promptly by 8.30am. The coach will return to school at approximately 4pm.

A packed lunch **WILL BE PROVIDED by the centre**, but you may also wish to provide a couple of healthy snacks to see them through the day. They will also need a bottle of water.

Following a year when so much has been disrupted by COVID, we are able to heavily subsidise the cost of this visit this year, to provide this opportunity for the children. However, we do request a nominal amount of £10 per pupil which will include pizza and a drink for the children at the sleepover, and this is payable via Tucasi. This will be the only financial parental contribution we ask for this trip. We need to secure the booking by 6th December, so ask that this payment is made by **3rd December 2021**. Please remember to tick the permission box.

Nearer the time, we will be sending out a Blackland Farm dietary form which will need to be filled out and returned to the school office, suggestions for clothing and footwear for the day, what will be required for the sleepover and the pick-up time for Saturday morning.

If you have any concerns or are aware that your child will not be able to attend, please let the office know immediately.

We are sure that this trip will be an excellent and beneficial experience for your child.
