Extraordinarily for this year, due to the COVID situation and to best protect Fr Seán and Fr Stephen, they will not be meeting parents in person to sign the SIF forms.

The general process for applications remains the same. Before the closing date for applications:

- Parent/Carers complete their Local Authority Common Application Form online.
- Parent/Carers must also complete the SIF and return it to the school.
- The school will formally log receipt of each SIF form from each Catholic applicant.
- The school will then take all the Catholic applicants' SIFs to the priest in one go for the priests to complete the relevant section for each applicant and return to the school.

Surrey - Club4 returns for Christmas

After its successful roll out during the summer holidays The Club4 programme (known nationally as Holiday, Activity and Food Programme - HAF) is returning for Christmas. This initiative is for children in Reception class up to school year 11, that are <u>eligible for benefits</u> related free school meals or classed as vulnerable. It aims to give them a healthy meal in a fun, active and stimulating environment during the holidays.

FINAL CHRISTMAS FAYRE PREPARATIONS!

The PTA are pleased to announce the Christmas Fayre is finally here and we very much look forward to welcoming all children, parents and carers on **Sunday at 12pm**.

To ensure the safety of all visitors a large number of the activities and stalls will be held outside in the infants' playground - please wrap up warm. Latest weather forecasts are not predicting any rain - we very much hope it stays that way!

Entry to the Fayre will be through the double gates. If you have already purchased your tickets to the Fayre please bring your email receipt with you as proof of purchase. Additional tickets will also be available on the gate.

All of the children's activities and products for sale will be cash free, so parents will need to purchase an activity ticket either online in advance of the Fayre, or at the gate. Adult purchases can be made using either cash or card.

Each Children's activity ticket (£5) includes 10 stamps which can be exchanged by the children as they visit different stalls. Children will be advised at each stall how many activity stamps are required. We have many items and activities priced at one stamp. If parents have purchased activity tickets in advance, please bring your receipt with you and collect your tickets at the gate.

IMPORTANT - We need to ensure the safety of everyone so we would encourage all visitors to take a lateral flow test (LFT) prior to attending the Fayre. If you are experiencing any COVID symptoms we would insist that you don't attend the Fayre. We will refund any tickets purchased for those unable to attend due to COVID. If you go into the school building during the Fayre we would ask that you wear a mask.

Additionally, a number of areas around the school will be marked off with tape - these areas are out of bounds. The notable area is the infants and junior play equipment. Parents are responsible for their children at the Fayre and we would ask all parents to ensure their children don't enter these areas!

REMINDER: Tickets for the Raffle are only available online so we would encourage everyone to purchase any tickets ahead of the Fayre. Tickets for the Raffle, Fayre entry (adults only) and Activity tickets can all be purchased online using the link below;
