Covid

As Covid rules begin to ease please continue to be careful and follow the rules. The new variant is apparently in the London area and we all need to be careful. We still have staff who are not yet vaccinated and need to be mindful, so we would appreciate it if you could continue to wear masks on site at drop off and pick-up time.

Covid Testing: Please note the Government rule still remains: <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>

If your child develops any of the three symptoms you must keep them off and ensure they have a full PCR test and the result is known.

If you have any of these 3 coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, use this service to get a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test as soon as possible:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- you've lost your sense of smell or taste or it's changed

You can order a PCR test kit to be sent to your home or book an appointment at a walk-in or drive-through test site. If you have symptoms, you and everyone you live with must immediately self-isolate. Do not leave home until you get your test results, except to post a test kit or for a PCR test appointment.

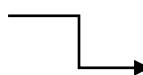
If the PCR test is negative children may return to school. PCR tests are coming back fairly quickly, within 24hrs, at present if they have been done at a test centre.

Lateral Flow Tests are only aimed at identifying adults and children that are a-symptomatic. If you or your child develop the symptoms mentioned above, you still have to go for a full PCR test.

Thank you to all the parents who are dealing with this and keeping us informed, we appreciate how difficult and disruptive it is.
