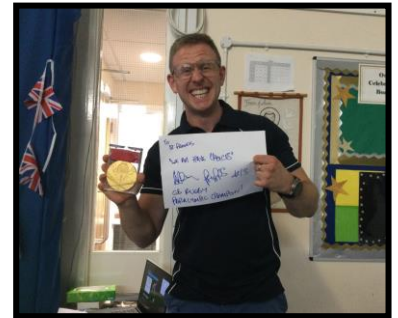


## Value of the month – Responsibility

**Note:** For those with children at other schools, please check their arrangements as the additional Jubilee date may vary.

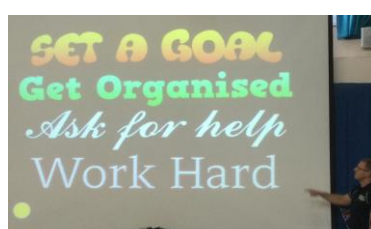
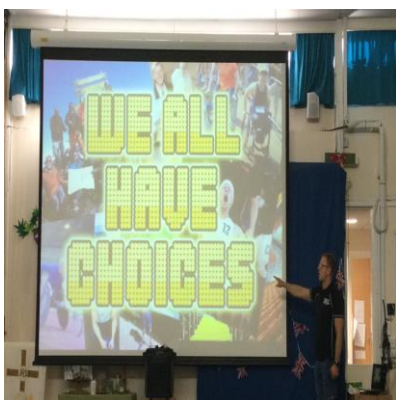
