Tickets for the lottery cost just £1 per week. There is a guaranteed cash winner for St Francis School each week and a chance to win a £25,000 jackpot


The local St Francis School cash prize varies each week based on the number of tickets purchased, so the more tickets in the draw the larger the cash prize.
