Dear Parents and Carers

Well, we have made it to Advent! Our value for December is Patience and we shall endeavor to be like Mary, Mother of God, and look forward to celebrating the birth of Jesus with patience, joy and hope – all important values.

Advent Collection for Cafod

As part of our Advent preparations we will be beginning with our Advent Reconciliation Liturgy. We always support Cafod at this time of year and collect for individual class Cafod gifts, however, knowing how difficult it is this year, we made the decision that instead of each class donating their own CAFOD gift, there will be one gift donated from St Francis' School as a whole. So, we would ask every pupil, if possible, to bring in a voluntary donation of coins, as we usually do, for the Advent Reflection Liturgy. This contribution will be used to purchase the CAFOD World Gift. The gift we give is dependent on how much we collect, but we are hoping to give either a 4-Gift Bundle (a goat, a chicken, some books for children and a kitchen starter kit) or a 6-Gift Bundle (a goat, a chicken, books for children, a mini-library for a school, a kitchen garden starter kit and some toys for children)

Extraordinarily for this year, due to the COVID situation and to best protect Fr Seán and Fr Stephen, they will not be meeting parents in person to sign the SIF forms.

The general process for applications remains the same. Before the closing date for applications:

- Parent/Carers complete their Local Authority Common Application Form online.
- Parent/Carers must also complete the <u>SIF</u> and return it to the school.
- The school will formally log receipt of each SIF form from each Catholic applicant.
- The school will then take all the Catholic applicants' SIFs to the priest in one go for the priests to complete the relevant section for each applicant and return to the school.
