Positive Covid Tests in the Final Week: Isolation Notifications

Please be aware that if a child or staff member develops Covid symptoms and tests positive in the final week, we will still need to contact you, even after we have broken up, to ensure you know and to tell you that your family will need to isolate. Depending on the date of the positive test, it means there may be a need to isolate in the lead up to Christmas, or even over Christmas. Mrs Brown and I will be monitoring the Office email for notifications of positive tests, via parents, the Local Authority or Test & Trace, so do keep a look-out for messages from us. The key to when to begin isolating is the two days prior to a positive test. Obviously, we have no control over this, or over how quickly tests are returned. If we are contacted in the lead up to Christmas, we will email you as quickly as we possibly can. We are all desperate to celebrate Christmas with our families and I am praying that I do not have to send an isolation message to anyone!

2021-22 Catholic Applications - for Reception places for St Francis' Catholic Primary School

For those needing a <u>Reception place in 2021-22</u>, there is a <u>Virtual Tour of the School</u> on the Admissions page of the website. Please do remember to read and follow the Admissions instructions below. If you need any help or advice on Admissions, do contact the School Office

Extraordinarily for this year, due to the COVID situation and to best protect Fr Seán and Fr Stephen, they will not be meeting parents in person to sign the SIF forms.

The general process for applications remains the same. Before the closing date for applications:

- Parent/Carers complete their Local Authority Common Application Form online.
- Parent/Carers must also complete the <u>SIF</u> and return it to the school minus the section usually completed by the priest.
- The school will formally log receipt of each SIF form from each Catholic applicant.
- The school will then take all the Catholic applicants' SIFs to the priest in one go for the priests to complete the relevant section for each applicant and return to the school.
