2021-22 Catholic applications – for Reception places for St Francis' Catholic Primary School

Extraordinarily for this year, due to the COVID situation and to best protect Fr Seán and Fr Stephen, they will not be meeting parents in person to sign the SIF forms.

The general process for applications remains the same. Before the closing date for applications:

- Parent/Carers complete their Local Authority Common Application Form online.
- Parent/Carers must also complete the <u>SIF</u> and return it to the school minus the section usually completed by the priest.
- The school will formally log receipt of each SIF form from each Catholic applicant.
- The school will then take all the Catholic applicants' SIFs to the priest in one go for the priests to complete the relevant section for each applicant and return to the school.

Net Aware

More and more children are using video sharing apps to create and share their content with friends online. It is important to make them aware about what they're sharing and how to use these apps safely.

Net Aware, produced by NSPCC and O2, have released <u>content to help parents and carers</u> who may be worried about their child sharing videos and images online. The content discusses why children use apps like TikTok and Snapchat and provide guidance for parents and carers to help keep their children safe including:

- Setting their account to private
- Reminding them not to post their locations in real time
- Not sharing personal information
- Talking to them about sexting and sharing nudes

Your child will have a new login, which will be stuck into their Home School Contact Book for **Zumos**. Zumos is a leading online wellbeing system that is CAMHS kitemarked and was developed as part of the HeadStart project.

We at St Francis' are passionate about building strong mental wellbeing and resilience in all our pupils. This is why as a school we have embraced Zumos as a major part of our school's pastoral care.

During this very difficult time where everyone is expected to spend long periods of time stuck at home it is even more vital that we take care of our children's mental wellbeing as well as our own. As we have this great resource available to us and your child already has a login, we are asking if you would be willing to take your child through some of the features each day and help them to practice the techniques as a fun family activity.

The system has been developed to follow a curriculum, so all you need to do is sit with your child, get them to login and play the recordings outlined below. It is a great thing to work on together or as a family. The messages are very powerful, we know our teachers love to hear them too. If you like you can discuss the recordings and ensure the messages have been understood.
