The harvest comes because of the grain that dies..." Rooted in love, the life of Saint Oscar Romero continues to bear a harvest of goodness today. His deep commitment to the poor and passionate belief in justice continues to inspire many, including the work of CAFOD. And so, inspired by his example, let us speak out for what is right, stand up for what we believe in, and play our part in making the world a fairer place for all people to live.
