This coming Sunday is Peace Sunday and the 55th World Peace Day. It is a day for prayer for peace. We have been writing prayers for peace in our world in their classes.

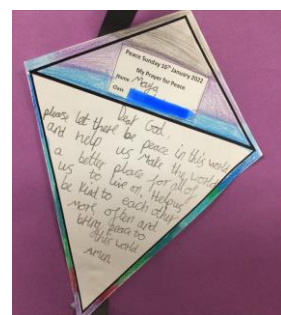


"How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the messenger who announces peace" (Is 52:7).
