The PTA are pleased to announce the Christmas Fair is finally here and we very much look forward to welcoming all children, parents and carers on **Saturday at 12pm**.

The Fair this year will be split between the school hall and the infants playground - weather forecasts suggest it will be cold - please wrap up warm. We will have a selection of hot drinks and hot food available in the hall! Cash or card accepted!

Entry to the Fair will be through the double gates. If you have already purchased your entry tickets (adults only) to the Fair please bring your email receipt with you as proof of purchase. Additional tickets will also be available to purchase on the gate.

All of the children's activities and products for sale will be cash free, so parents will need to purchase an activity ticket either online in advance of the Fair, or at the gate. Adult purchases including food and drink can be made using either cash or card.

Each Children's activity ticket costs £5 and includes 10 stamps which can be exchanged by the children as they visit different stalls. Children will be advised at each stall how many activity stamps are required. We have many items and activities priced at one stamp. If parents have purchased activity tickets in advance please bring your receipt with you and collect your tickets at the gate.

A number of areas around the school will be marked off with tape - these areas are out of bounds. The notable area is the infants and junior play equipment. Some areas of the school will also be closed off. We would ask all parents to ensure their children don't enter these areas!
