Deanery Schools Initiative

Please read the information below on the St Peter's (pupil led) Petition regarding School fruit and Fairtrade bananas. You may wish to consider supporting their petition - the link is in the information.

This term, St Peter's Catholic School's International club has been learning about Fairtrade issues and were really shocked to find out that the bananas that are sent to school as part of the Free School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme for KS1 children (which is government funded) are not Fairtrade! Every day, approx. 2.3m children aged 4-7 in state-funded schools receive a free piece of fruit which includes bananas. We think that not including Fairtrade bananas in this scheme is setting a really bad example to children around the country and we want the Government to change this. We have started an online petition to the Government to request that they consider changing all the bananas in the scheme to Fairtrade bananas which has received support from the Fairtrade Foundation and our local MP, Chris Grayling as well as being featured in the Universe Catholic Weekly. https://universecatholicweekly.co.uk/universe-weekly-newsletters/january-2023/UNIVERSE-13-JANUARY.pdf?mc_cid=a99c610561&mc_eid=f76863778 We need 10,000 signatures by the end of January 2023 to get a response from the government so we are asking for your help in telling people about it.
