

SCHOOL UNIFORM			
These uniform expectations have been reviewed in line with current Department for Education (DfE) guidance, ensuring that our school uniform remains affordable, inclusive and practical, while promoting a sense of belonging and pride within the school community. All children are expected to wear the school uniform. The school colours are dark blue and light blue. All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with the child's name. A change of shoes for outside play (an old pair of trainers) is required. In severe weather, children may wear boots or wellingtons travelling to and from school but must change into school shoes or black plimsolls in school. Neither fashion shoes nor fashion trainers are appropriate school wear and should not be worn during any part of the school day. JEWELLERY - no jewellery should be worn in school. It is Surrey County policy and school expectations that children are not permitted to take part in any form of physical education if wearing jewellery. Parents wishing to have their children's ears pierced should do so at the beginning of the summer break so that studs or hoops can be removed by the time the Autumn term begins. HAIR – Long hair needs to be tied back. Accessories should be simple, safe and in school colours – dark blue/light blue. Hair gel and unusual or fashion hairstyles are not permitted COATS -All children should have a dark coloured coat or anorak. If it is cold in May or September, the winter uniform option may be used.
